

An appendix includes numerous sample budget forms and instructions, allowing you to see firsthand the various types of budgeting forms used in day-to-day practice. New "Budgeting for Information Systems" chapter describes how to budget for information technology (IT), what kind of personnel you should consider hiring to support the nursing IT function, and how to evaluate IT products. A discussion of magnet hospitals has been added, including the cost implications of applying for "magnet" status. Budgeting for clinics and same-day surgery facilities is described. Updated and expanded content discusses budget variance analysis and interpretation of budget reports that differ from the planned budget. Includes the budget implications of outsourcing, and how to determine whether outsourcing is cost-effective for a particular service.

Amazingly, this is a really good book. I say "amazingly" because it is, after all, a book on budgeting. However, it's a clear and concise read for a nurse who has zero management or budgeting experience. I am enrolled in a DNP program in the Nurse Executive tract and my career goal is management. The author's use of examples clarifies the confusing subject matter of this book and makes it easy for me to apply these concepts in my practice, despite the fact that I'm not in a management position. My manager has even said, "Maybe you can teach me some things!" See, I'm already indispensable ;)

The best part of this book is the recognition that most of us have moved into management without any formal training, and then explained the concepts as if we do not know anything (we do not) without making us feel like fools.
