

If you are a suffering Christian or know of one, this book will bring enormous comfort • and insight into the ways of God.

Gene Edwards is one of America's most beloved Christian authors. He has published over twenty-five best-selling books, and his signature work, The Divine Romance, has been called a masterpiece of Christian literature. He has written biblical fiction covering nearly the entire Bible, with titles that include the following: The Beginning, The Escape, The Birth, The Divine Romance, The Triumph, Revolution, The Silas Diary, The Titus Diary, The Timothy Diary, The Priscilla Diary, The Gaius Diary, and The Return.

This book was not my cup of tea. It is historical fiction based on some assumptions about John the Baptist's life. The book is short and very, very simple. This is good for many, but not for me. The author makes some assumptions that I think are almost certainly wrong, but it is fiction, so that's supposed to be okay. The author has some absolute historical truth in book as well and that is good. The point of the book is excellent: don't be embarrassed or offended by Christ. That is a message today's Christian desperately needs. This is why I gave the book four stars. It also because I realize that most of today's masses do not read and most never read another book after they graduate from high school. This book is perfect for those folk. It would also possibly be good for youth. They should read it and may be blessed by it.
