

This is a book most people don't mention as being good for the clerkship/shelf. However I found it extremely useful and fairly comprehensive. I used this + UWorld and scored in the 95th percentile.

FA managed to do really well here. I used this to prep for the 2CK and found it to be an easy read. Covers a broad range of topics in sufficient (i.e., not excessive or long-winded) detail. Would definitely recommend this as an adjunct to an obgyn rotation and for the 2CK.

This edition is a bit outdated for some of the definitions and screening guidelines. Just be aware of some conflicting information in that regard
