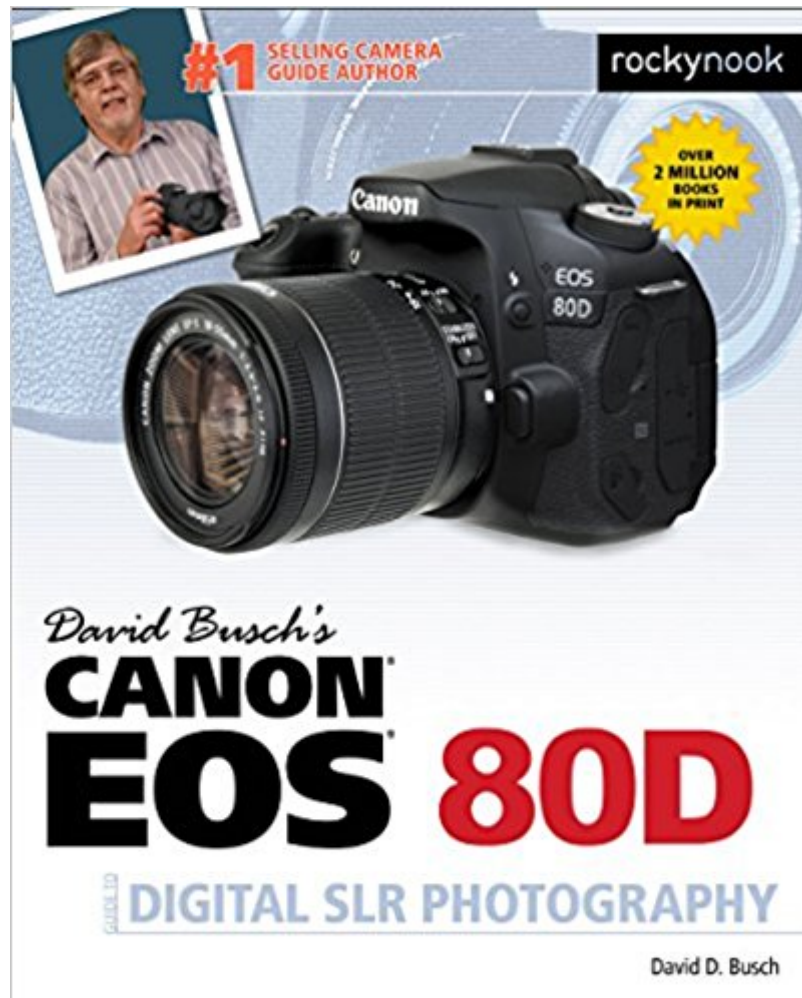

My suggestion is to go out and use it on automatic mode, and then read a bit use a new mode, and then repeat. Eventually, you can work yourself up to the manual/semi-manual mode. I like this book because you can jump around to learn everything from basic to advance camera techniques and issues. This is not a book you read from cover to

cover, but more of a reference manual for what you what to learn right now. It's such a thorough resource, I highly recommend it.
