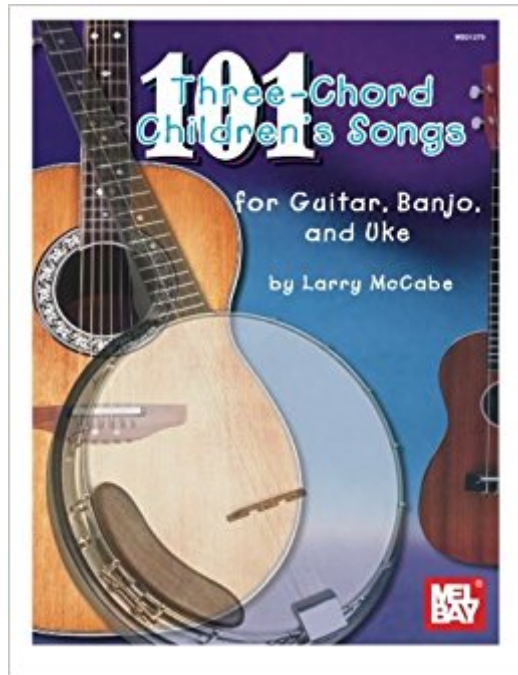

Larry McCabe was born in Kansas City, Missouri. He studied music with a number of teachers including Eldon Shamblin, legendary swing guitarist and arranger for Bob Wills. Deciding on freelance teaching as a music career, Larry received his degree in education from the University of Arizona in 1979. An experienced blues guitarist, he played in the Gulf Coast Blues Band, wrote a Living Blues magazine column called "Blues Box," and is currently on the nominating committee for the annual W. Beginning with Blues, Boogie and Rock Guitar in 1984, he has written a number of Mel Bay books on various subjects including guitar, bass, and song writing techniques.

I am new to the guitar, but not music. I wanted to some music I could entertain my two young boys with and did not want any complicated arrangements. 101 songs using G, C and D7 fits the bill. This is not for the experienced guitar player, as you might find the songs limiting, as written. In all, I am happy with the book and my boys get a kick out of watching daddy play and sing.

I have several of these 3 chord songbooks and they are usually pretty good for the beginner in getting you going with a simple melody and this is no exception. My reason for rating it as 3 stars is one song - "Three Sight-Challenged Mice" (Page 121). The words and the cadence of "Three Blind Mice" have been modified to fit someone's vision of correctness.

My only complaint is that they changed "3 Blind Mice" to "3 Sight Challenged Mice"

This book just includes the standard notation for the music, without any tab. To say it's for banjo and uke is a little misleading. Might as well say it's for French Horn, clarinet and piano too.
