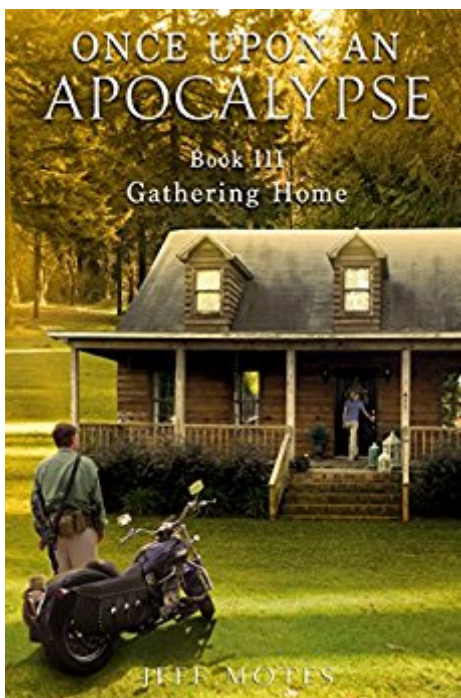

I very much enjoyed this 3rd installment. Like some other reviewers, I also think this was probably the best book. It almost instantly brought me back into this very scary (but very possible world).In particular, I've often thought about how close almost all of us are to being a Jimmy. How bad circumstances combined with some bad decisions can quickly change a life trajectories. I imagine most of us would do almost anything to prevent our family from starving to death. This is actually why training is so important because people by and large tend to make the wrong choices when in a very stressful situation. But training and planning can reduce this tendency.I also thought the ending was very nice. Mr Motes brought everything together, with a bit of a surprise, but one that was well substantiated by the evidence. I look forward to seeing where this story goes.

I hated to put this book down to go to bed and finish the next morning. It could be my favorite of the three so far, but I say that with each one. You get so wrapped up into the story you just want to scream at the pages. I had to be quiet because my husband reads them, too, ha! You feel like you are right there with the characters, your heart races and your blood pumps. All of it is written realistically and you can easily see it happening at any moment in life. I am ready for a Book Four now, and the waiting for a new one begins again....

The continuing story of how people of faith deal with the survival decisions they must make in an apocalyptic world. One passage as the grandfather is talking to his grandson, really moved me.
