

Typical high quality Lonely Planet guide, intermediate between backpackers' style and luxury style. Aimed at travelers, rather than mere tourists. That is, we like to interact with the locals and get immersed in the ambiance of each place we visit, rather than just check off a list of tourist sites visited. We use Rick Steves for Europe and Lonely Planet for the rest of the world.

Good book, buy it before you book your trip though.

Fiji is unique because of the 3 cultures: Fijian, Indian, and British. This has caused political unrest (check the news before you go in case there is a coup). But in general, you will have a diverse experience compared to the other Pacific island groups. I compared my experiences with the descriptions in Lonely Planet and think the book is a good guide (things change slowly in Fiji). There is a variety of landscapes and seascapes so you will need to make some choices. And if you want to visit the Yasawa or other island groups, you definitely need some advice. I loved the Blue Lagoon Cruise with its multiple experiences packed in a short time span (oh, and it's beautiful beyond words). While local prices are cheap for the residents, Fiji has gotten progressively more expensive for the tourist. The book tries to steer the budget traveler toward accommodations, tours, and transport.
