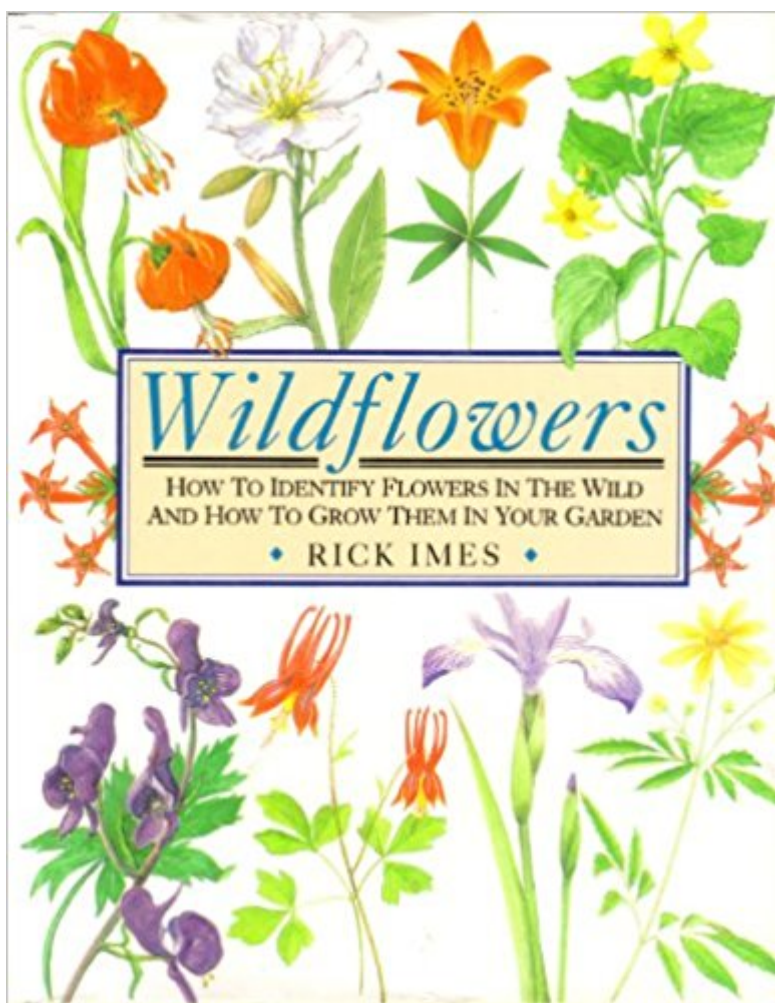

This is a great book. My wife and I have been wildflower enthusiasts forever, built up a big wildflower book library, and this has always been one of our favorites. Here's why. If you want to identify wildflowers on hikes or roadsides, usually you buy a Field Guide, right? The famous Audubon Guide is probably the most popular, and it's great. There are others, too. But these guides are for ID only. Most people, after they're interested in wildflowers, want to grow some at home. Well, your Field Guide will not help you. For growing information, you have to go into the "How to Grow..." group of wildflower books--a completely separate group, and usually quite expensive. Of course, there are many great ones. However, this book by Rick Imes is one of the few that gives you both. It's easy to use, and unless you find a really rare wild plant, it'll have all the flowers you'll ever find or want to grow. I knew Rick years ago, and he is a very serious, knowledgeable guy. For

this book, he worked out a really easy system of classifications, etc. It's a true general consumer guide to wildflowers. Highly recommended.

I would've granted this book five stars if it had had a few more plants in it. Everything you really need to help you with those seeds & pods you collected hiking, and now wonder if you should wait until spring, or plant them now. This is the book for you if you recall what the flower looked like, or know it's common name and can read an index. You will be able to find it in these lovely, beautifully colored drawings that make it surprisingly easy to recognize that pretty little flower you saw on that last trip, and the author will tell you how to prepare the roots or seeds, when to plant or transplant them and how to plant them. A real joy to just peruse as well, and get an idea of what to search for on your next trip.
