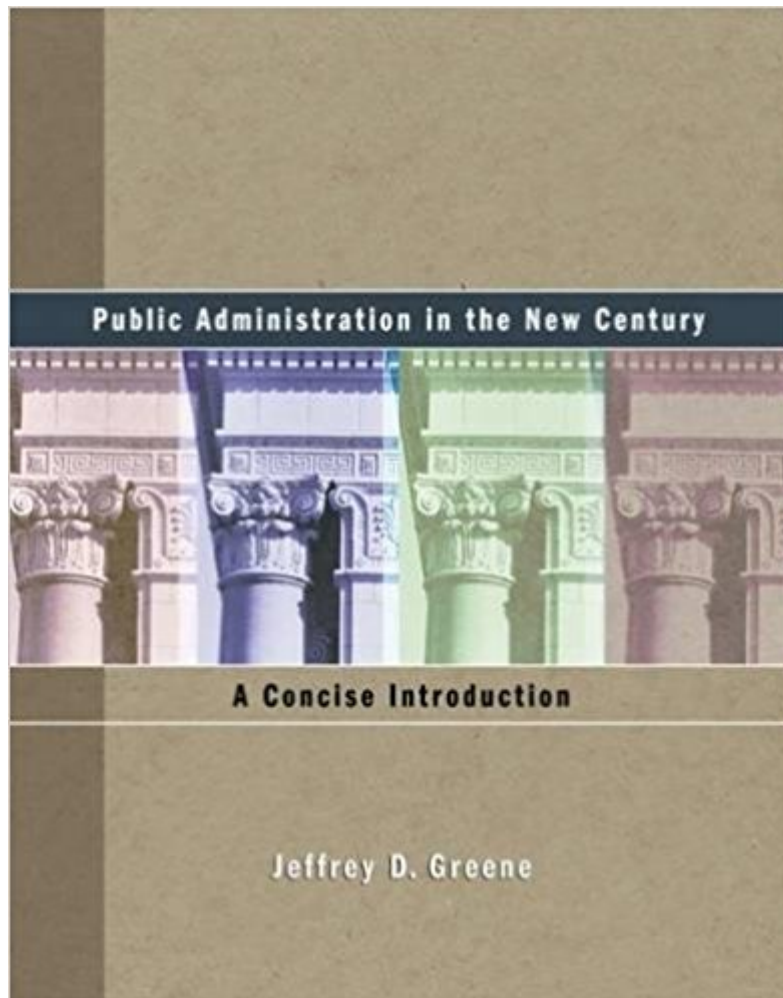




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Professor Greene is a native of North Carolina and received his Ph.D. from the University of South Carolina. His current research project is a public policy book titled THE POLITICS OF VICE.

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
