

But over all, Catherine Keller brought in a rich historical and prolific analysis, cited multiple authors that might not typically be synthesized, and proposed a positive yet challenging narrative.

"On the mystery" is a cogent and passionate exploration into process theology and its implications for life. My only negative is that Keller often seems to belabor her points. Otherwise this is a splendid book.

This volume treats mystery seriously, not as a puzzle to be solved but as something to be penetrated without ever reaching the core.
