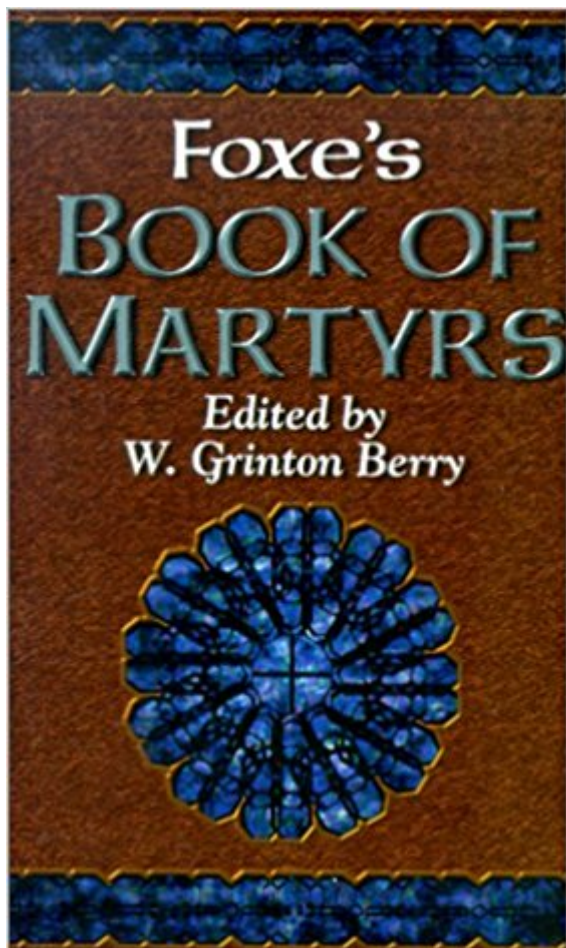

The book speaks for itself. It is a simple, readable account of the many martyrs for the faith up to the author's time. Fox was a man converted from Catholicism to Protestantism, and expelled from Oxford because of it. His last edition was some 2000 pages long and very famous in this time. In 1900 or so, it was abridged and the language was modernized by WB Forbush, which, with few changes is this edition. The font is clear and readable and large for this edition. The short biography at the front is very helpful. I highly recommend this edition. As the writer of Hebrews wrote (probably referring to Paul's and Peter's martyrdom), "Remember your leaders, who spoke the word of God to

you. Consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever" Heb 13:7-8 NIV. Our leaders exemplify our Lord's sacrifice for us. They pass on, but he always remains for us to trust in.

Excellent for reviewing what your Christian heritage had to pay for our freedom to worship . Most of these martyrs, were killed by the Catholic Church, which is downplayed in the book. I wonder if its been edited out, or if Foxe himself did that.

Buckle your seat belt and hold on. The nightmare treatment of people who dare to disagree with the Catholic Church and the Pope is beyond anything I could have imagine. Fox captures and documents the inhumane treatment of people who would not march in lockstep with the Catholic church leaders. If you are looking for an easy read this is not for you. I was and am horrified at the cruelty demonstrated towards people who would dare to disagree with the Pope and all done in the name of Christianity.
