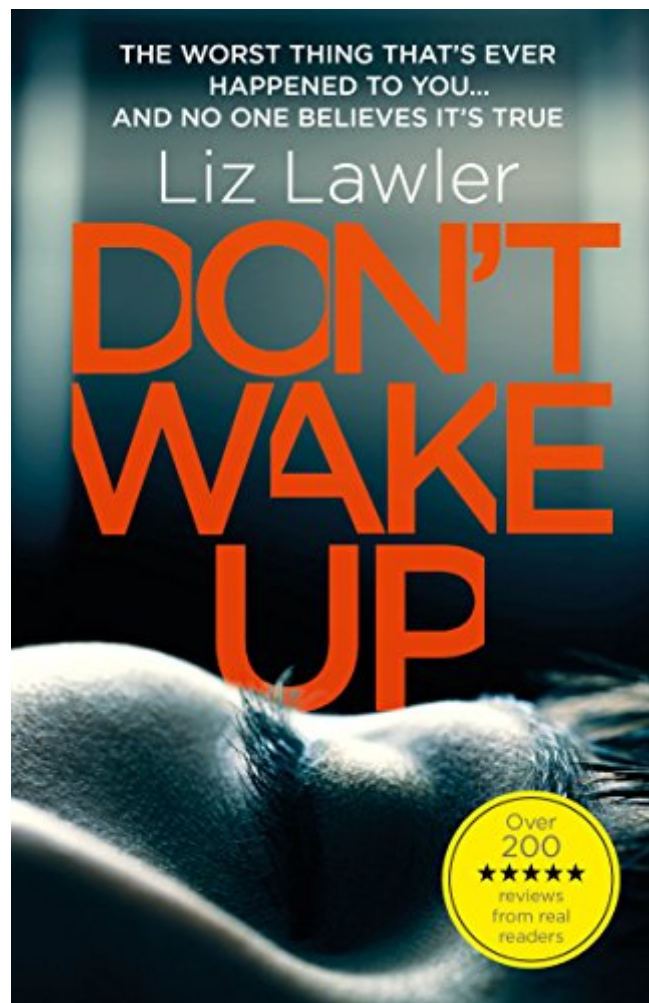

A good read. A little slow sometimes, but the last few chapters had me reading as fast as I could. The only thing that does not make sense to me is the way nobody believed the protagonist. We find out early on that she is a great doctor, very intelligent, very capable and friendly, and yet when something horrible happened to her, not one person believed her, not her boyfriend or her closest friends, which to me did not ring true. A little predictable, but in general, a good thriller.

The things I liked was the writing style, the obvious research into the medical field to make the story believable as far as that goes and the author's knowledge of police work even though there wasn't much there. But I am tired of the "disbelief" plot angle. No one believed what happened to the main character and that is unbelievable to me. As the plot developed and the characters fleshed out, this became less of a problem for me so kudos to the author for that. But I have seen that storyline before and I don't like it. Other than that I did enjoy this book. There were a few typos in it due to formatting I suppose, but not enough to detract.

It was good but not great. I see more and more books having the words 'gripping' or 'riveting' in the title which I try to avoid. That's trying too hard to get someone to buy in my opinion. I have read books that have caused me to bring a flashlight onto the patio so I will be undisturbed to read the book. Those books were gripping and exciting without announcing it in the title. This book was not one of those.

I can't imagine anything worse than not being believed! This book grabs you from the first page. The fact that the theme is based within a medical framework lends even more credibility.
