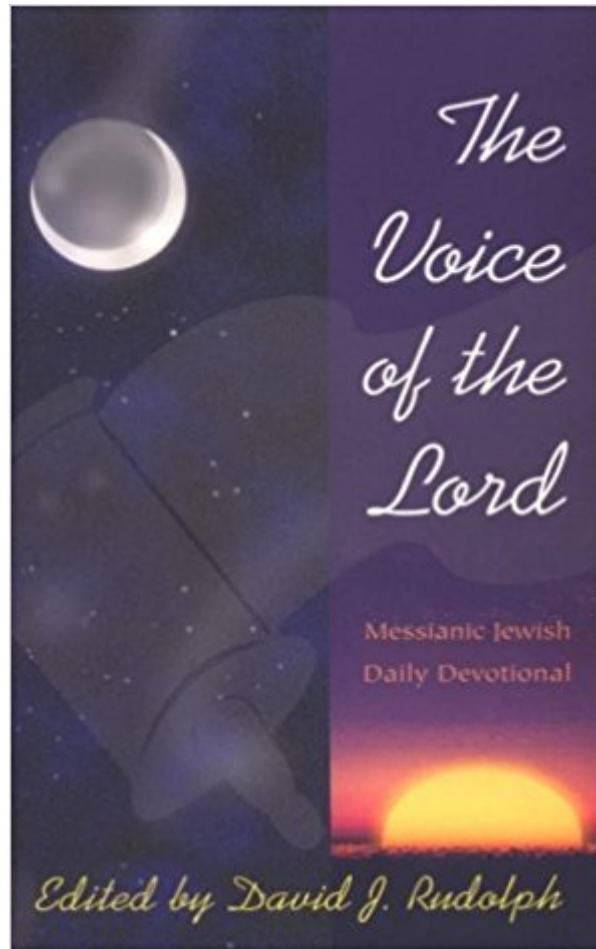

I've been wanting to get more into the Hebrew/Messianic teachings, and this is such a great way to do that. It's a daily reading that will help you see from a Hebraic mindset -- with the knowledge that Yeshua is Messiah at the same time. Remember Yeshua or Jesus is Jewish - - so we need to understand things from that view point as well. We've missed so much by not connecting with our Jewish roots, and it's time the church did -- it is a blessing to read these pages and to see truths from a different perspective that we have not touched because we have not had the benefit of teaching from a Hebraic mindset. I bought copies for my sister and niece once I got it, I knew they would be blessed by it as well.

This is a magnificent collection of devotionals, by many of the most notable Messianic Jews in the world today. Moreover, the book provides a veritable river of information regarding the Biblical calendar with its annual cycle of Scriptural readings, God's appointed times, and Jewish traditions. The devotionals often include amazing stories of Jewish faith, Talmudic stories, Hebrew terms, and Yiddish sayings, all presented in an informative, explanatory way that allows them to be absorbed and incorporated into practical lessons for the readers life with great ease.

This is a favorite devotional for our family, in fact all of us have a copy for ourselves. Hard to find decent Messianic devotionals. Sometimes you have to edit out/ignore a comment that is TOO rabbinic in flavor/authority OR TOO CHURCHY, but overall it's very handy! Like this a lot! We don't agree with all of the comments at the end of the book, but overall it's a fair deal and helpful. Very good! We've seen some prayer concerns of the week, be addressed at times, in the daily devotional (of course that can happen with anything if you are trying to pursue the Voice of the Lord for real....not just the title of this book). I recommend you buy this, if you are Messianic, and are willing to study things you may not agree with on occasion. We have 5 copies! The book is also very nice for keeping up w/ Rosh Khodesh, the Feasts, & the other various national Biblical holidays (nothing secular, nothing invented by the "church" or anything similar). You will learn about our Jewish brethren along the way. Also, Messianic Judaism views can be learned a little bit throughout .... but keep in mind it's only ONE flavor of Messianic Judaism that you'll be hearing from (most authors / contributors are members of a particular circle). We bought this devotional in 2008 Summer I think, and years later it's still a favorite of our daily use. Enjoy and grow!

In years past, my daily devotional was Our Daily Bread from Radio Bible Class, and it never failed to speak to my heart. But since coming into the Hebrew Roots Awakening, I have wanted a devotional with a Messianic "flavor", if you will. I am fully enjoying this devotional, written by several Messianic teachers and leaders. It speaks more to where I am now in my walk with my heavenly Father and Savior. I highly recommend it to others.

I read through this book last year. It had what I sought in a Messianic devotional book, being based on the rich Hebrew context of Scripture and coinciding with the biblical holidays and Jewish parashas. I was blessed as I read the messages morning by morning. I noticed several errors in grammar and usage and a couple in content, so I began an electronic dialog with the publisher. He assured me that my corrections would be incorporated in the next edition. I can't wait for a second volume to be released!

My cousin originally recommended this little book and I am enjoying it in a way that I had not considered I would when I first purchased it! Although I am a Christian myself...my ancestors were Messianic Jews. The daily devotionals give me the Jewish perspective of scripture and further my understanding of how scripture can give a daily lesson in living a more productive life for the Lord.
