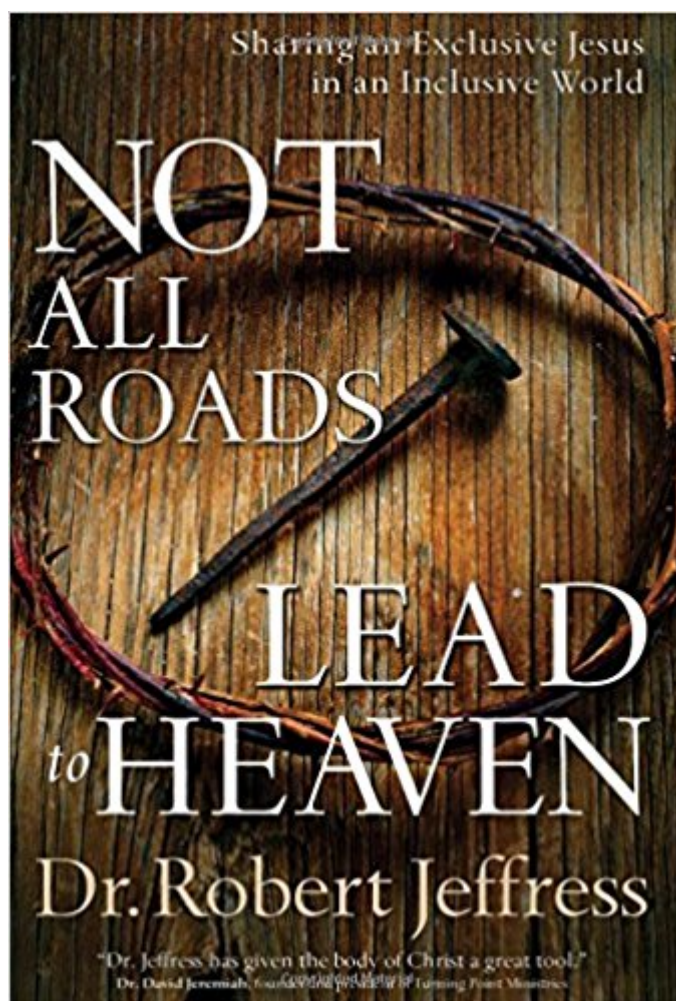

I will not comment on the content of this book, only the quality of the product. Pros: Comes in a plastic case, which is better than the cardboard boxes audio books usually come in. There is a notification of the beginning and end of each CD. The presentation was easy to follow. Cons: Each sleeve holds a CD on the front and back, but it can be difficult getting the CDs out and in while driving.

Well, according to Dr. Robert Jeffress in his latest book Not All Roads Lead to Heaven, it is the Biblical teaching that faith in Jesus is the exclusive way to heaven. The Intolerant Christ 7. What about Those Who Have Never Heard? 8. What about Those Who Could Never Believe in Christ? Dr. Jeffress addresses these questions and several more with sound and simple Biblical arguments. After reading this book I know I am better equipped to fulfill the Biblical mandate to give a reasonable answer to some of the most difficult and important questions of our Christian faith.
