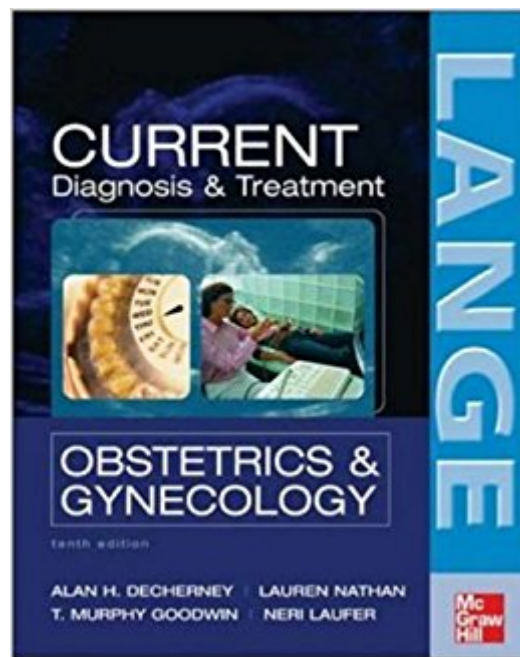

I would definitely accompany this text with Medical Embryology by TW Sadler which gives you all the essential vocabulary words with pictorials and sets the foundation for the embryology section of this book. I would also purchase What to Expect When You ARE Expecting...this one as a source of reference and hobby reading...we still need to know what mothers and teenage nongestational mothers read out there and be as informed as mothers can and should be. The use of technology is over-rated...for example ultrasound, genetics/karyotyping is also under valued and well teratogens as a cause for abortions well also lacking. However, we do have genetics as a separate course and embryology too...and pathology and physiology.

LexiComp has a phone app that updates regularly. Unfortunately, I can't get reception at most clinics. This book is well written. Medications are listed alphabetically with brand names, uses, unlabeled uses, drug class, interactions, dosage calculations, dose adjustments for children/renal/hepatic/elderly, dosage forms available. It even has pronunciations (soo doe e FEN rin)for those of us who tend to trip over words.
