Using Exodus 32 as scriptural foundation, Connilyn Cossette brings to life this 12-month period with a realistic and fast-moving plot. Moses and Aaron are mentioned, but it's the well-developed characters who give the reader a believable view of camp life with everyday problems and joys.
